Queries Answered.
PARKHILL.—You had better consult
a lawyer as to the point supplied and
the completion of the job, in case you
apprehend difficulty with C. The facts
are not explicitly stated. Your pay-
ment of \$25 to B before notice of the
lien by C on the point was good, pro-
vided that sum did not exceed 50 per
cent of the contract price of the job.
The lien of C is lost unless within 30
days of supplying the point he has
commenced an action for registered his
lien. We understand this was not done,
and that as it happened six months ago,
it is not too late for him to do so now.
Your course seems to be to hire
man to put on the point and use it up.
Then, if after paying the price, there
is any surplus left on the contract price
with B, you can then suggest that C
should reimburse the surplus on ac-
count of the point sold by him to B
against whom C has a legal claim.

DELAWARE.—A and B own adjoin-
ing lots; the line fence between them
being buildings owned by A, who moves
and removes them, and without any
consultation or notice to B erects a
fence and demands immediate payment
for it from B. In default of which he
is going to take the fence away. Can
A compel B to pay for fence, which is
to take fence away? Has A a legal right
to take fence away? Can B's lot?
fence erected for B to pay for?
By award of fence-viewers may com-
pel B to maintain half of line fence. A
cannot legally remove the fence erect-
ed by him without six months' notice,
and refusal by B to pay for it such sum
as the fence-viewers may award. A
is part of the half of the line fence
maintained by B.
