Notice of Legislation.

Application will be made at the present session of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, by the Town of Dalhousie, for legislation for the purposes following:

1 To empower the Town to purchase and acquire the title to and within the Town, and to convey or lease the same for a long term of years to Chappell Brothers to provide for them a free site for their proposed lumber mill or mills and plant, and to grant to them certain exemptions from taxation and other concessions as inducements to them to establish their proposed mill or mills and plant at the said Town.

2 To authorize and empower the said Town to issue debentures of the Town for an amount not exceeding \$12,000, at a rate of interest not greater than five per cent, payable in thirty years, for the purpose of enabling the Town to purchase said land and make provision for the granting of such concessions.

All in accordance with the express wish of a majority of the ratepayers of the said Town, as expressed by a vote of such ratepayers taken on the first day of March, A. D. 1911, by authority of the Town Council of the Town, A. D. 1911.
