Farmers' Parliament.
SOCIETY OF GRANGERS.
The Society of Grangers has avowedly for its object legislation for the best interests of the agricultural population. The order in the Dominion is about eleven years old, and has a membership in Ontario alone of about thirty thousand. The order is composed of sub-granges, which in their turn send representatives to the Provincial Grange. The order was first planted in Nova Scotia in 1871 by the organization of Acadia Grange, No. 1, in Colchester County. At present there are 90 sub-granges in operation in the Province, eight division granges and one Provincial Grange, with a total membership of about 2,000, chiefly in Colchester, Digby, and Kings counties. In the whole Dominion there are some 875 sub-granges. The Provincial Grange has also jurisdiction over New Brunswick, where are also a number of additional granges, and will have the corporate name of the Nova Scotia and New Brunswick Provincial Grange.
