The program may be expected to include the latest and best in the entire field of pomology. Arrangements are now making for the presentation of subjects of presentday importance by the leading authorities.

Early September is a delightful period in

the Lake Ontario section. All members of this historic society should arrange to attend this convention; new members are welcomed.
