At the Toronto Convention of the Ontario Educational Association, April 21-24, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

> "THAT THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SECTION OF THE O.E.A. REQUEST THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION TO CHANGE THE REGULA-TIONS SO THAT A GRAFONOLA WITH A SUITABLE NUMBER OF APPROPRIATE RECORDS FOR EACH CLASS-ROOM BE MADE PART OF THE COMPULSORY EQUIP-MENT OF PUBLIC AND SEPARATE SCHOOLS."

The resolution was subsequently amended by omitting the words "for each class-room."
