DIOCESE UF CALGARY -- PROGRESS.

The Bishop asks the readers of the SOWER to jo'n bim in devout thankfulness to Almighty God for the gratifying fact that there are 'now twenty c'ergym in holding his license at work in the Diocese of Calgary, and the arrival of Mr. Wooden will increase the number to twenty one. There are also two paid Lay readers, one temporarily and the other permanently. but both wholly engaged in work among settlers.

The total number of clergymen in the present Diocese of Saskatchewan is twenty-one. This was the number in the undivided diocese when the Bishop was consecrated (August 1887) of whom eight were laboring in what is now the Diocese of Calgary.

There is need for at least two more at once, one to be stationed at Olds, on the C. & E. R., and the other to work among the settlers at Egg-Lake, Lobstick, and Victoria; some of whom sent the Bishop an urgent petition lately.

The Bishop earnestly pleads for more funds to help to provide stipends for clergymen for these two missions, as well as for grants for the building of churches and parsonages, and the general advancement of the work.
