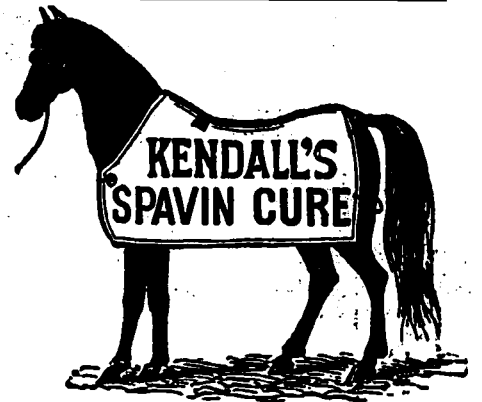

On Money Orders payable within Canada the commission is as follows:
