Objectives

The three main objectives of the Historical Division are:

- to collect and disseminate accurate information about the Department's evolution and Canada's past foreign policy;
- to develop co-operative relations in the research field with the Department's academic constituency at home and abroad;
- to establish a research and data base for other Divisions of the Department.

Publications

Documents on Canadian External Relations

The Division collects and disseminates information on Canada's past foreign policy through the publication of *Documents on Canadian External Relations*. Volumes 1 to 9, covering the years 1909 to 1943, and Volume 12, covering 1946, have been published since 1967. Volumes covering from 1944 to 1949 are in various stages of completion and should all be available by 1983.

Documents on Relations Between Canada and Newfoundland

Volume 1 covering defence, civil aviation and economic affairs, 1935 to 1949, was published in 1974. Volume 2 concerning political negotiations leading to confederation, 1940 to 1949, is in preparation and should be available in 1980.
