

he was released, but restricted to his home in Bulawayo. Later that year, he was released to attend the Geneva Conference as a member of Bishop Muzorewa's delegation, but he crossed the floor to join Robert Mugabe's ZANU (PF) team.

In the same year, he was elected Publicity Secretary of the People's Movement Internal Co-ordinating Committee of ZANU (PF). In January 1977, following his return from the Geneva Conference, he was again arrested for his political activities. He was released on November 26, 1979.

The President has travelled widely. He has written four tracts on politics and religion, and has made contributions to several magazines and journals.

President Banana is married. He and his wife have three children.
