NOTING that both Canada and Romania are parties to the *Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material* (the "CPPNM"), adopted in Vienna on 26 October 1979 and have ratified the *Amendment to the CPPNM*, done in Vienna on 8 July 2005;

NOTING the decision of Romania to construct a tritium removal facility to extract tritium which builds up in the heavy water moderator and coolant in the Cernavoda CANDU nuclear power reactors and Canada's desire to co-operate with Romania in that project;

DESIROUS of further developing additional areas of co-operation;

INTENDING, therefore, to co-operate with one another to these ends;

HAVE AGREED to supplement the Agreement as follows:

ARTICLE 1

- 1. This Protocol supplements the Agreement and is interpreted together with the Agreement.
- 2. The Agreement remains in force and the provisions of the Agreement apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to this Protocol unless otherwise provided herein. Article IX of the Agreement applies to this Protocol.

ARTICLE 2

Definitions

- 1. For the purpose of this Protocol:
 - "confidential information" means confidential information or information that is privileged or otherwise protected from disclosure under the law of a Party;
 - "technology" means technical data including, but not limited to, technical drawings, photographic negatives and prints, recordings, design data, and technical, operating and maintenance manuals and instructions, blueprints, plans, diagrams, models, formulae, engineering designs and specifications, written or recorded on other media or devices such as disk, tape, read-only memories, that can be used in the development, design, production, operation, maintenance, or testing of equipment, facilities, nuclear material or material, but excluding data available to the public;
 - "tritium" means compounds and mixtures which contain tritium in which the ratio of tritium to hydrogen by atoms is greater than 1 part per 1000;
