THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS WILL BE HOST AT A RECEPTION ON JUNE 13 AT THE RIDEAU CLUB FOR A GROUP OF APPROXIMATELY 80 EUROPEAN AND AMERICAN DELEGATES TO THE RECENT CONFERENCE OF NATO POLITICAL YOUTH LEADERS WHICH TOOK PLACE IN WASHINGTON. THESE DELEGATES ARE VISITING CANADA FOR A TWO-DAY STUDY TOUR WHICH WILL INCLUDE VISITS TO OTTAWA AND MONTREAL. THEIR TOUR IN CANADA IS BEING SPONSORED BY THE CANADIAN POLITICAL YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS AND HAS BEEN CO-ORDINATED BY MR. D. JUNG, M.P.

THE MEETING OF NATO POLITICAL YOUTH LEADERS IN WASHINGTON WAS THE FIRST SUCH CONFERENCE TO BE HELD IN NORTH AMERICA AND IT WAS ATTENDED BY A LARGE CANADIAN DELEGATION. THE PRESENT STUDY TOUR OF CANADA BY EUROPEAN AND AMERICAN DELEGATES HAS BEEN ARRANGED TO ACQUAINT THEM WITH CANADA AS A MEMBER OF NATO.
