By Mr. Campbell:—Order of the House for a copy of all correspondence, letters, and other documents in connection with the removal of the post office of Maloneck, Saskatchewan, from the residence of Mr. W. S. Jones to another part of the district.

By Mr. Campbell:—Order of the House for a copy of all correspondence, letters, and other documents in connection with the dismissal of Joseph Lalonde from the position of postmaster at Saint Front, Saskatchewan, and in connection with the appointment of his successor.

By Mr. Campbell:—Order of the House for a copy of all correspondence, letters, and other documents in connection with the dismissal of Mr. W. Stasink from the position of postmaster at Poplar Bluff, Saskatchewan, and the removal of the office from the original location.

By Mr. Campbell:—Order of the House for a copy of all correspondence, letters, and other documents in connection with the proposed change in the position of postmaster at Hyas, Saskatchewan.

By Mr. Campbell:—Order of the House for a copy of all correspondence, letters, and other documents in connection with the dismissal of J. Schram from the position of postmaster at Fort Pelly, Saskatchewan, on the charge of political partisanship; and also all similar papers in connection with the appointment of his successor.

Mr. Woodsworth, seconded by Mr. Heaps, moved,—That, in the opinion of this House, the time has come for the establishment of a National System of Banking.

And a Debate arising thereon;

Mr. Speaker having arrived in the House, took the Chair.

And the Debate continuing;

Mr. Irvine, seconded by Mr. Garland (Bow River), moved,—That the said proposed Resolution be amended by striking out all the words after the word "come" in the second line and inserting therefor the following:—

"for the consideration of the improvement of our banking system and that the Banking and Commerce Committee be instructed to study possible improvements and report thereon."

And the question being put on the amendment; it was agreed to.

And the question being put on the main motion as amended; it was agreed to.

Mr. Garland (Bow River), seconded by Mr. Irvine, moved,—That, in the opinion of this House, the time is now come when the further development of our country requires the establishment of a National Research Institute, and that this should be undertaken by the Dominion Government.

After Debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion; it was agreed to.
