While the percentages were proportionately lower in the older two age groups, off-farm work was reported by some 53,000 out of a total of about 178,500 farm operators.

What is not apparent or available from this type of analysis are the reasons for working off-farm and the use or relative importance of the off-farm income. Some earlier preliminary work in this regard is attached in Appendix A.
