absent, but at least his Assistant who was looking after the Observatory should have acknowledged my reminders and let me know the reason for the delay. It was because of this that I felt there was not much use in writing further to the Observatory. I have just now received a letter from Professor Kelly stating that he did not receive my letter of the 23rd of June, and when he received my letter of July 3rd, he found it necessary to wait until he returned to the City. I am glad however, that the matter has now been satisfactorily settled, and I trust that in future these unnecessary delays will not occur.
