V. The prinaiples which govom research voris siould be uniform throughout the thivorsity. Tho diectenlties which jom, sugecot ase such as might easily arise in any departinezt of the thiversity atd wo hove not so fox falled to solvo thom.
VI. The question of salarios is one which iuvolves a very careful inquixy
 there is cyy insuyprable diesioulty here, and I have no hositation in assuring you thet the professobs in the Peoulty of Lerleulture 1111 rocelve absolutely pair trootmont. Fronotion is and mast always be carried out with thé good of tho Thivorsity only in vieng. If a proies sor at lasdonezt seons the most suitablo persum for yeonotion in his dopartnont, ho wili nisurodly recelve it, 3 eannot soe that exy huriship would be worised in this may.
VII. It ray be desiruble to eanyleto tho woris of fusing denurtmonts at onoe; if moy on the other hrmi prowe cosireble to lot then atand. af those yon rofer to the oniy dopinitely seiontifie departoment is becteriozoig, and I see mo insuyerable obstriclo to the erronement in thet 30.se. It is not quite correat to say that the Dopartmont of Gelwulosa Ghenietry is not undori Ghemistive It is on the same sooting as the othor Iargo subdivisions of the Department of Chemistry and works as they do, nore or less as a separste enti,ty, but all subdivisions together form the reasum
Deporimont of Ghomistry. I soo no grepeteriver thorafose why you should not have a Depertment of Agricultural Chens.atry which would operate moro or less by itsolf, but form nevertheless an intogrel part of the Departinont of Chonistay. The gane might bo caid of the Departinont of Fintamolong and the Depertmont of plent Patholocy.
