APPENDIX.

32 GEO. III. Cap. 46.

An act for establishing courts of judicature in the island of Newfoundland, and the islands adjacent.

Preamble.

His Majefty, under the great feal, may inffitute a court of criminal and civil jurifdiction at Neaojoundland, &c.

OR the better administration of justice in the island of Newfoundland, and the islands adjacent; be it enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Lords fpiritual and temporal, and Commons, in this prefent parliament affembled, and by the authority of the fame, That it shall and may be lawful for his Majefty, by his commiffion under the great feal, to inftitute a court of criminal and civil jurifdiction, to be called, The supreme court of judicature of the island of Newfoundland, with full power and authority to hold plea of all crimes and misdemeanors committed within the island of Newfoundland, and on the islands and feas to which ships or vessels repair from the island of Newfoundland, for carrying on the filhery, and on the banks of Newfoundland, in the fame manner as plea is holden of crimes and mifdemeanors committed in that part of Great Britain called England, and alfo with full power and authority to hold plea, as herein-after mentioned, of all fuits and complaints of a civil nature, arifing within the ifland of Newfoundland; and on the illands and feas aforefaid, and on the banks of Newfoundland; which count
