The Steamers of the Liverpool Line sail Semi-weekly between Liverpool and Quebec throughout the season of Summer Navigation; and from Liverpool every Thursday, and from Portland every Saturday during the season of Winter Navigation, the vessels of the Mail Line calling at Moville to receive and land Passengers and Mails to and from Ireland and Scotland.

The Steamers of the Halifax Line sail fortnightly between Liverpool and Quebec, or Baltimore *via* Halifax, N. S., and St. Johns, N. F., during the season of Summer Navigation; and between Liverpool and Baltimore, *via* Halifax, during the season of Winter Navigation.

The steamers of the Glasgow Line sail weekly between the Clyde and Quebec during Summer, and at intervals between Glasgow and Portland during Winter.

RATES OF PASSAGE.

From Quebec or Portland to Liverpool or Londonderry. — CABIN, \$70 and \$80, according to accommodation. STEERAGE, \$25. Children under 12 years of age, \$6 per head in After Cabin, and \$5 per head in Forward Berths; under 1 year, Free. In Steerage, over 1 year and under 12, \$2 per head; under 1 year, Free. Servants in Cabin, \$50.

Steerage Passengers require to provide their own Beds and Bedding, and Eating and Drinking Utensils.

From Quebec or Portland to Glasgow. — CABIN, \$60; INTERMEDIATE, \$40; STEERAGE, \$24. Children under 12 years of age, \$5 per head in Cabin; \$3 per head in Intermediate; and \$2 per head in Steerage. Under 1 year, Free.

From Halifax to St. Johns, or vice versa. — CABIN, \$20 or \$18; Children from 1 to 12 years, \$2 per year. STEERAGE, \$6; Children from 1 to 12 years, 50c. per year.

From Baltimore to St. Johns, or vice versa. — CABIN, \$35; Children from 1 to 12 years, \$3 per year. STEERAGE, \$20; Children from 1 to 12 years, \$1.75 per year.

From Baltimore to Halifax, or vice versa. — CABIN, \$20; Children from 1 to 12 years, \$2 per year. STEERAGE, \$12; Children from 1 to 12 years, \$1 per year.
