LOCATION

The City of Victoria, the capital of British Columbia and the most westerly city in Canada, is situated at the extreme southern end of Vancouver Island, opposite the entrance of the great Puget Sound, and within a few hours' ride of Seattle, Tacoma and other Coast cities. On the

south and west are the Straits of Juan de Fuca and the Pacific Ocean, and on the east lies that magnificent inland sea, the Gulf of Georgia, which, with its wealth of picturesque islands, out-rivals the more widely known Thousand Isles.
