

MORE ITALIANS COMING TO TORONTO AT PRESENT THAN AT ANY OTHER TIME

Two Thousand Have Arrived Already This Year
and All Are in Demand by Contractors and
Railways for Construction Work.

The recently closed Turkish-Italian war has upset the labor situation to such an extent in Italy that the migration from that country has reached record proportions. Canada, especially the province of Ontario, is receiving a very large share of it. In fact, every train arriving in Toronto from New York brings in from fifteen to twenty more Italians.

This was the statement made to The World yesterday afternoon by Prof. Sacco, government superintendent of the Italian immigration for the Province of Ontario, whose headquarters are at the Toronto Union Station and who has been in the hands every Italian locating in Ontario.

Prof. Sacco stated that while last year saw a fall in the Italian immigration to Ontario closed early in September, at the latest, they were now pouring in at as fast a rate as at any time during the season. The number came in by way of Montreal, but the vast majority arrive by steamship at New York from there come directly to Toronto.

Two Thousand This Year.
More than two thousand Italians have already arrived in Ontario this year as compared with nine hundred last year. The reason given by Prof. Sacco for this is the Turkish-Italian war and its demoralizing effect on the industrial life of Italy.

A good proportion of those now coming over are women and children, stating the government official. These are coming to join husbands, fathers and brothers. The general custom of the Italian is to come out here, save money, and in three or four years

time, obtain a place of his own. He then sends over to Italy for his family or relatives to come to Canada and join him.

High Wages.
The reason that Canada, especially Ontario, is getting such a good proportion of the Italian immigration is because the high wages being paid are becoming known throughout Italy. The Italian expressed by Prof. Sacco. Most of the Italians coming to this province locate right here in Toronto and on being given employment with contractors receive wages of from \$2 to \$3.50 per day. Those working thru Ontario with railway construction gangs receive from \$1.60 to \$1.75 per day, but are provided with sleeping quarters, thus making them practically as well off financially as those working for contractors in Toronto.

Best Worker.
"It is generally admitted by contractors here that the Italian is the best worker for construction work that is to be found and they are therefore greatly in demand," said Prof. Sacco. "It is, indeed, a fact that not only the Italian preferred as a construction laborer above all other foreigners, but the contractor would much rather have them than even Englishmen themselves."

"The demand for Italians in Toronto and the Province of Ontario is now far ahead of the supply, and although the number coming in this season is more than double that of any other year, I would have no trouble in placing even a larger number more Italians than are coming in."

ICE AS AN AID TO BEAUTY

"No, I mean ice, and I will tell you how to do it, and you do not need a single testimonial to convince you if you will stop and think. One reason why so many of us have no color in our faces is that the circulation is bad. USE OF OZONE FOR PURIFYING WATER.

Ozone works for the sterilization of drinking water have been erected in Wiesbaden, Paderborn, Hermannstadt and Chemnitz, in Germany; Paris, Nice, Chartres and Dinard, in France; Florence, in Italy, and St. Petersburg, in Russia. Eminent authorities agree that the plants in these cities are working satisfactorily.

The process of ozonization effects a complete destruction of all bacteria of typhoid, cholera, and dysentery that may be contained in the water. At the same time it is claimed that the number of so-called innocuous bacteria in the water is considerably diminished. The ozonization process may also be used on a small scale where sterilized or chemically pure water is desired. Public health authorities are also constructing for the ozonization of water in ice plants, in breweries, on board ship, or for any other purpose, which a limited amount of pure water may be demanded.

A representative of a large European concern manufacturing ozone apparatus claims that the ordinary conditions of the approximate cost of sterilizing water on an extensive scale is about one cent per cubic yard. This cost, however, refers only to the cost of operation after the plant has been installed. Experience up to the present time has demonstrated that the cost of the preliminary filtration, inclusive of the preliminary filtration, is about one-half cent per cubic yard, which amount the ozonization process itself costs the city approximately one-half.

A "LIVING TOWER" AND HOW IT CAME TO BE BUILT.

What is known as the "Living Tower" stands on the summit of a hill more than 200 feet high at Camp Meeker, a summer resort in Sonoma County, California. It was built by a pioneer who conceived the idea of constructing a hill near his hotel, and while looking around one day for a suitable site discovered four young redwood trees standing about twelve feet apart and representing a perfect square. Then it was explained a writer in The Wide World Magazine, that the idea occurred to the captain to build a "living tower."

The trees were each about 150 feet high. Fifty feet of each was lopped off, and the work of building six stories was then commenced. From top to bottom the "Living Tower" is 100 feet high. Each floor is about 12 x 12 feet, and rests on strong timbers, the ends of which are securely attached to the four trees by means of steel cables and bolts. So strongly was every part braced that the whole structure does not move as much as one would naturally suppose, even when rocked by heavy winds.

The tower has been carefully examined by builders and engineers, and pronounced perfectly safe. In the building great care was taken by the workmen to cut only the branches growing on the inside of the square, and the trees were not chopped, mutilated or weakened any more than could possibly be avoided.

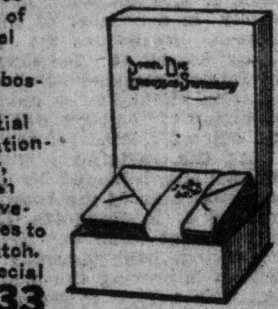

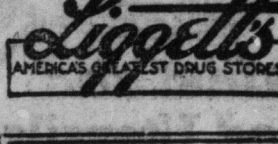
