

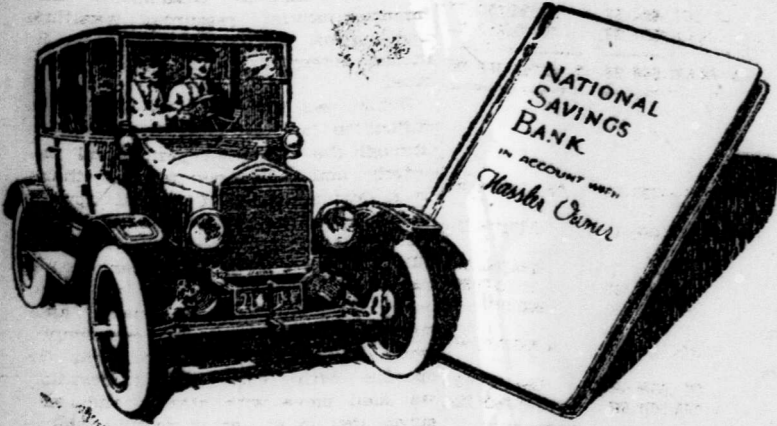

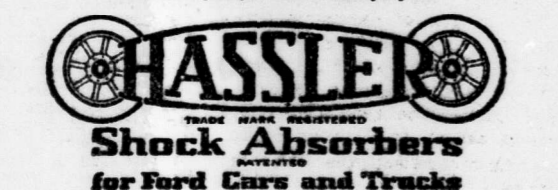

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## THREE OUT OF FOUR BUDGET PROPOSALS PASS IN COMMONS

### Resolutions Covering Business Profits Tax, Income Tax and Tariff Changes Go Through With Comparative Ease, But Main Resolution Imposing New "Luxury" Taxes Remains.

OTTAWA, June 4.—Three of the four budget resolutions passed through the House today with comparative ease. They were the resolutions referring to: (a) Business profit tax, (b) Income tax, and (c) Tariff changes, viz., placing appliances for the blind and certain books on the free list and reducing the extra 7 1/2 per cent war duty where still imposed.

But the main resolution remains. This is the resolution imposing the new luxury taxes, increasing the excise taxes on automobiles, increasing beer, wine and spirit duties and levying a sales tax of one per cent. Here, it is expected, discussion will be protracted with the probability of a number of government amendments.

Chiefly an Administration. Today's criticism turned chiefly on administration. It was brought out that if men who had failed to make income tax returns for 1917 and 1918 came forward now and admitted their error they would not be penalized. But the man who had not made his 1919 return was subjected to the penalties of the law. Was this quite fair, queried Mr. Euler of North Waterloo. The minister of finance took the view that there was no excuse for a taxpayer failing to make a return for 1919. Advertisements had been circulated over the hundreds of thousands. More- over, a result of issuing writs, collections had been increased by one hundred per cent. Fines imposed totalled \$35,000.

Another point was raised by Hon. T. W. Crothers, formerly minister of labor in the Union Government. Mr. Crothers complained that the taxation statutes were so complicated the average man could not understand them. "After studying the statutes for half a day I am no wiser," he said, urging that the statutes should be consolidated. Sir Henry Drayton admitted that the statutes were somewhat complicated and necessarily so. But every effort should be made to make their provisions easily understood by the taxpayer.

Tax Hydro Electric. Some of the Quebec members urged that the hydro electric of Ontario should be subjected to business profit taxes, as were the private electric power companies of Quebec.

## LOYD PREVOST FOUND GUILTY OF KILLING BROWN

### Never Saw So Much Perjury As in This Case, Says Judge.

MONTREAL, June 4.—Judge Deay, sitting in the court of king's bench, this morning delivered what is probably the shortest sentence ever imposed in the criminal court of Quebec, when he sentenced Joseph Prevost to serve an hour and three-quarters in jail, for stealing gramophone records and furniture to the value of \$600. The sentence was to begin at 10 o'clock, but at the time it was pronounced it was 11:45, so Prevost immediately regained his liberty. This sentence was due to the fact that Prevost's lawyer explained that his client had merely taken things which he understood belonged to him, and not to his partner.

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich., June 4.—Lloyd Prevost was found guilty of the murder of J. Stanley Brown by a jury in the circuit court here tonight. The jury was out approximately three hours. The verdict returned was "guilty of murder in the first degree."

After the jury had retired, Judge Lamb, in a statement charged that perjury had been committed, and ordered an investigation by the prosecuting attorney of the county. "In all my experience as a judge," he stated, "I have never seen so much perjury as I have in this case. The testimony has been so contradictory, and there has been so much perjury, as to make it apparent an effort has been made to cover up the truth."

Should an investigation by the prosecuting attorneys prove unavailing, Judge Lamb said, a grand jury should be called.

### DETECTIVES GUARD RADIUM

Dr. S. A. V. Sobchek exhibited the three grams of radium which will constitute the National Radium Bank's capital to the assembled physicians at the Waldorf-Astoria. It was contained in two lead cylinders eight inches in diameter, in which holes had been bored for the small glass vials which enclosed the pure radium.

It is the largest collection of American mined radium in existence, and represents the most valuable individual mass of the precious mineral in the world. The cylinders were watched closely by private detectives during the time they were in view, although it was declared that the radium would be quite useless to the ordinary thief.

The radium came from Colorado, and the United States is no longer dependent upon outside countries for the supply of this element. The founders of the bank are T. Coleman du Pont, Allen W. Everts, Redmond Cross and P. W. Bliss.

### Serility Premature.

Dr. Fisk's suggestion regarding the prolongation of human life came in a paper he delivered on "Preventive Diseases and Adult Life." He declared that serility was always premature, and that "youth is a physical state and not a function of time."

"To postpone middle and old age has seemed a quixotic and fantastic proposition," said he. "But even to double or triple it is a simple thing compared with communicating with the spirits of the dead. Some persons believe it irrelevant to talk of changing the life cycle established by God, but old age always premature, just as death from typhoid or tuberculosis is premature."

Physical culture is a result of the cumulative effect of antagonistic conditions. We find an analogy in changing the life cycle of the fruit fly has been increased 500 per cent, and the same proportionate increase would make man capable of living for 1,500 years.

It is possible, Dr. Fisk said, to make a category of conditions antagonistic to human life. Included among them are heredity, infection, poison, food, deficiency, food excess, fear, grief, emotional excess and psychic apathy due to lack of interest.

"The life cycle of every organism is limited by some fault in structure, causing self-poisoning," went on Dr. Fisk. "The turtle lives to be 300 years old, and the California redwoods are practically immortal. Of course, we have to consider that changed conditions may abolish all life on the earth, and my mind is open to that extent."

Members of the society protested against the report of the New York State League of Women Voters, published recently, in so far as it applied to physicians. A resolution was passed by the doctors declaring the organization opposed to compulsory health insurance because it undermines the firm ethical foundation upon which medicine now rests, and would make us "subservient to politically appointed commissioners."

Dr. Robert T. Morris told the physicians the war imperative need of establishing a home for aged physicians who are unable to support themselves.
