It is to be hoped that the Canadian Olympic representatives will succeed in their efforts to bring the athletic war in Canada to a speedy close, and that next year Canada will be represented by her best in the great athletic games to be held over the seas.

RUGBY. Harvey Pulford, the well-known Ottawa athlete, who witnessed the Harvard-Yale game, came back with the idea that the forward pass would help the Canadian game, while now the American Rugby authorities are advocating to do away with the forward pass next year.

This youngster, Fred Bellars, of the N.Y.A.C., is certainly a wonderful distance runner. Less than a month ago this 19-year-old boy defeated Daly and the great Bonnah in a four-mile run, and Saturday he won the cross-country championship of America. Bellars covered 6.4 miles in 33 mins. 12 sec., and defeated such cracks as Eisele, the Princeton wonder of last year; Daly, Collins, Bonnah and Joyce of the Irish-Americans. The young fellow is just such a performer as was Frank Nebrieh, who won the event last year.

TURF. Joe Marrone, the owner of St. Joseph, was defeated from Benning's track Monday, and his horse was not allowed to start in the fifth race on account of alleged doping. Marrone has now entered suit against the Washington Jockey Club for \$25,000, which is a few cents more than he could ever have made with St. Joseph.

BASEBALL. According to a Pittsburgh expert on averages and baseball figures, Ty Cobb of the Detroit club did not bat .352 last year. He admits that the young Tiger should lead the league, but says that the official score is off his beat on the .352 figures.

After many hours of work over the records, he says, he has discovered that Cobb's figures are .350, the same as Wagner's in the National League. He gives columns of figures to show that he is right, but his figures do not agree with the official in important details, and it is impossible to go back of the official. The fact that Wagner batted .350 may have something to do with the discovery that Cobb's average is no higher.
