Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations
The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditions.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of each of the three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 40 acres, and his conditions. A habitable house is required, except where residence is performed in the vicinity of a homesteaded point, on certain conditions.

Live stock may be substituted for cultivation on a homesteaded point, on certain conditions. A settler who has exchanged his homesteaded right may take a purchase homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre.

TRADE IN CATTLE
A LITTLE SLOW

Most Butchers Were Twenty-Five to Thirty-Five Cents Lower.

HOOGS GO HIGHER
Lamb's Were Slow and Fifty Cents Lower—Calves Were Strong.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards yesterday consisted of 90 cattle, 1151 calves, 174 calves, 2378 hogs and 269 sheep and lambs.

There were 1101 cattle of all grades on sale at the Union Stock Yards yesterday, and the great bulk of them were common to medium quality and half-bred animals.

While buyers on Monday rushed from one pen to another and bought every thing at a price out of all proportion to the value of the cattle, it was a different story yesterday. Buyers were slow and desultory in their purchases and as a result butchers were down from 20c to 30c on the pound.
