Emperor Francis Joseph of Austria-Hungary is Dead Aged Monarch Passes Away After Long Life of Sorrow and Suffering—Archduke Charles Francis Succeeds

Francis Joseph, Emperor of Austria-Hungary, died last night at nine o'clock at Schoenbrunn Castle. The first intimation that his health was failing was given on November 12 and later it was announced that the heir apparent would be associated with him in the government of the country on December 2.

PICKLE MEN PAY \$100. A TON FOR CAULIFLOWER

Riverhead, N. Y., Nov. 22—There is such a shortage of all articles that can be used for pickles this year that agents of pickle manufacturers paid as high as \$100 a ton for cauliflower to farmers here this week. Riverhead is reputed to be the principal cauliflower market of the country. Early in the season many growers were glad to get \$20 a ton for the vegetables.
