

London, Dec. 11.—The annual report of the U. S. Secretary of the Navy, which calls for appropriation of \$30,-000,000 for the modernization of the U. analy, is commented upon by the Daily Chronicle, which points out that the projected appropriation does not cause the least alarm or suspicion, as it might once have done.

"So far from either country taking unbrage at reports of this kind," says the newspaper, "there is a disposition in toth Great Britain and America welcome joint responsibility licing the waters of the world."

The Chronicle adds that Britain re gards a strong U. S. navy as "an added guarantee of the peace of the world."
