IN SWITZERLAND

Geneva, Switzerland, July 6—(Associated Press by Mail)—Switzerland has reached the acute stage of economic stringency resulting from a too favorable rate of exchange. The tourist seasoph, upon which she depends to such a great extent, opened with little prospect of an improvement in the situation.

Tourists who usually visit Switzerland during the summer, are going to French and Italian resorts.

The Swiss, themselves, to a considerable extent, are abandoning their own country to spend their outings in France where Swiss money counts for twice its value at home, or in Italy, where it counts five times the normal value.


