

# AN ABSTRACT, &c.

## SESSION XIII.

### DIET I.

ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH, TORONTO,

Thursday, July 6th, 1843.

The Synod of the Presbyterian Church of Canada, in connection with the Church of Scotland, met, according to appointment, and, in the absence of the Moderator, was constituted with prayer by the Reverend James George, the last Moderator present.

Presbytery Rolls were called for, and several given in.

The Moderator, and other members from Canada East, having been prevented from reaching town hitherto, from some delay in the public conveyance, the Synod adjourned till half-past six o'clock this evening, then to hear the Moderator's Sermon. Closed with prayer.

At half-past six, the Synod met, pursuant to adjournment, and, after Sermon by the Moderator, the Reverend Henry Esson, from Gal. v. 1, "Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage"—was by him constituted with prayer.

Presbytery Rolls were called for, and the whole of them being now given in, the Synod Roll was made up, and read over as follows. [An asterisk is prefixed to the names of the members who were present in the Synod]:—
