We returned well not plead guilty of POW as charged but will plead guilty to POW's from 1980 to 1985. From 1985 until 1986 surrounded himself at 1180 km 5 Apr 85 to a Captain of the U.S. Army Intelligence Corps at Bangkok. was there.

We had no contact & except the plea and the forwarding Officer Ensign on behalf of the Commanding Officer under RPOWH.

Recalled in June 1993 and came on scene in Apr 84. Going to POW on 5 June 84. Had 9 am meeting 9 were a rifleman, 9 returned and was media engine in Jan 85. 9 was wounded in action on 11 June 84 9 was evacuated to Eng land for about 2 1/2 weeks then on my return & the unit 9 was a para rifleman until Dec 84. Then 9 was wounded a second time but not seriously. My unit was in Viet when 9 went POW. When we came back to Viet we had a new pl. of 7 and met with when 9 had got along we had a new pl. of 7 and met with and was told 9 was going 9 was last on parade in morning and was told 9 was going to be sent back to a rifle reg as punishment. Also saw 9 & he went back to a rifle reg 9 knew and 9 wanted to see them people left in the reg after 9 knew and 9 wanted to see them with the unit at a camp. 9 had no leave with the unit. 9 went to Paris with last 9 was afraid of being caught by U.S. Parents as 9 went with out of Paris 9 went from village to village, I avoid suspicion. Then when 9 was captured 9 would be placed as a deserter 9 took the opportunity of remembering myself to an American Captain on 5 Apr 85
