Robert J. Murdoch, Son of City Engineer, Visiting His Parents After Five Year's

Robert J. Murdock of Kamloops, B. C., son of Wm. Murdock, city engineer, arrived in the city yesterday on a months' visit to the home of his parents. He is accompanied by his sister, Miss Jessle Murdock, who is returning from a visit to the West extending over a year.

During her trip she visited the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition at Seattle last year, Victoria and Calgary, staying longest at the latter place, where she has relatives.

Speaking with a Standard reporter last evening, Mr. Murdock said Kamloop's chief industry was real estate. He said that it had a rapidly growing population of 3750, was the commercial centre of a rich surrounding gountry with two saw mills, and a large railway business, being the function of the main line of the C. P. R. and its branch line. It was on the foot-hills of the Rockies on the two Thomson Rivers 267 miles from Vancouver. Its population had increased three-fold since his first arrival.


