

2. Election of Representatives to District Divisions, first regular meeting of the Division in January.

Any member in good standing eligible for election. Ratio of representation, one member for each Division, and one additional member for every ten members on the Financial Scribe's books. Credentials to be forwarded to the District Scribe in time for the January meeting of the District Division.

3. Election of Managers of Bands of Hope, first regular meeting of the Division in October.

Four male Directors to be elected by the Division, and three ladies, to be chosen by the elected managers and approved by the Division.

4. Appointment of Agency Collectors, first meeting of the Division in January.

One or more Collectors may be appointed, and their names and addresses should be sent to the Grand Scribe without delay. Duty of the Collectors: To solicit contributions for the Agency Fund from members of the Division and friends of the cause; to report amounts collected to the Division, and to forward the same, with full lists of subscribers, to the Grand Scribe.

PUBLICATIONS OF THE GRAND DIVISION.

1. The YEAR BOOK, which contains the journal of proceedings of all the sessions of the Grand Division held during the fiscal year, the Annual Reports of County and Districts Deputies, the Agency and Band of Hope work, lists of Deputies and Divisions, and a large amount of information interesting to every Son of Temperance.

2. The AGENCY REPORT, containing reports of the Agents and Lecturers, Financial Statement, and full lists of all donations, subscriptions and public collections received for the Agency Fund during the fiscal year. Every subscriber of 25 cents and upwards is entitled to a copy.
