The committee to arrange for the proposed visit of H. R. H., the Governor-General, met in the Council Chamber on Wednesday evening and arranged the following programme:

On arrival of the royal party at Wolfville station about 2 30 p. m. August 16th, they will be received by the Mayor and Town Council, and an address of welcome presented.

A guard of honor will salute H. R. H. After the address and reply the members of Council and citizens present will be presented to their Royal Highnesses.
