An Act to Amend an Act to Provide for the Conditional Liberation of Penitentiary Convicts.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of Preamble.
the Senate and House of Commons of Canada enacts as
follows :—

1. The provisions of chapter 49 of the statutes of 1899, 1899, c. 49
5 intituled *An Act to provide for the conditional liberation of* applied to
Penitentiary Convicts, shall apply to all persons convicted of convicts in
any offence and being under sentence of imprisonment in any jails and other

tory prison a license to be at large in Canada upon the like
terms and conditions as are by the said Act prescribed and
authorized with respect to penitentiary convicts.
2. The said Act and this Act may be cited respectively as Short titles.
