

III. And whereas the number of Elementary Schools, for the foundation or institution of which the *Fabriques* are by this Act enabled to purchase, might be insufficient in the Parishes in which there are towns and villages—Be it therefore further enacted, by the authority aforesaid, that in every Parish in which there shall be a town, a borough or a village of more than fifty inhabited houses, the *Fabriques* may found and establish as many Schools as shall be deemed fit; Provided that in the whole there be not more than one for every two hundred heads of families, domiciliated and residing within the said Parish.

IV. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Property which may be purchased by the said *Fabriques* for each of the said Schools, shall not in any case exceed in annual Income the sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds currency, not including the annual value of the Buildings and Dependencies of the same, employed immediately for the maintenance and service of the said Schools, for the lodging of the Masters and their Families and other persons employed for the said Schools, nor finally the Furniture and Effects of any kind which may be destined for the use of the said Schools, or of the Masters or Pupils.

V. Provided also, and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Schools, and the Property which shall be purchased for their foundation, endowment and support, shall be under the inspection and administration of the same persons, and subject to the same Rules which are prescribed by the Laws of this Province for the government and administration of the Property and Establishments of the said *Fabriques*.

VI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that in order to support and maintain the Schools which may be opened and established at any time hereafter by virtue of this Act, every *Fabrique* shall be entitled, until it shall have acquired Property for establishing and containing the said Schools, to apply out of its annual Income in the several Parishes in which such Schools may be opened and established under and by virtue of this Act, a sum of money not exceeding in any case one-fourth of the actual Income of such *Fabrique*.

VII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said *Fabriques* shall annually account in writing, on the third Sunday after Easter, at a meeting of the Inhabitants of the Parish, stating an account of the Income and Expenditure of the said Schools for the twelve preceding months, and of the number of Pupils and the name of the Schoolmaster;
