

THE CANADIANS CAN CURL.

THE NATIVE RINKS GRANDLY VICTORIOUS IN THE GREAT BONSPIEL.

The Americans Defeated by a score of 782 to 500—Twenty-nine Rinks on Each Side—The Record in Detail—Entertained at Dinner at the Walker House.

The great international bonspiel is a thing of the past. Victory, and a very decisive one, has rested with the Canadians, whose brilliant playing was pronounced by many as unsurpassable. Several of the visiting rinks more than held their own, and taken as a whole, they were completely outplayed. As Mr. A. M. Stewart of the Scottish-American, and one of the chief admirers of the game, remarked, the Canadian representatives unquestionably proved their right to be classed as wonderful players.

The play commenced simultaneously at 11 o'clock yesterday in the rinks selected.

Col. A. A. Stevenson of Montreal was the umpire at the Granite Rink, Matthew Hutchinson at the Adelaide, and A. M. Stewart at the Mutual Rink.

At 1 o'clock an adjournment was made for lunch and probably at 2 play was resumed.

Large numbers of interested spectators, including many ladies, watched the contests.

At each of the rinks refreshments were furnished the curlers, whose comfort was as far as possible attended to. Before the hour agreed upon for discontinuing play, it was generally known that the visitors had suffered a disastrous defeat, which, however, they accepted with commendable equanimity.

When the scores had been tabulated, President Flavelle of the Ontario Branch called a meeting of the visiting rinks and speeches followed in rapid succession until the gathering broke up.

Then followed a supper at the hotel which routed the Yonkersmen, of

which President Stewart of the Grand National Curling Club of the United States was skip.

Both offers of these important curling organizations, it is said, did not go well as any of their members were represented by twenty-nine rinks, nine of which played on open ice. Despite the fact that they were five games behind the open ice players, the visitors were easily two to one to the deficit of Milwaukee's third, and to the Thaneville club who scored in detail the most points.

Some of the visitors accounted for their poor showing by the fact that they had come to play the ice, but in making this explanation they had no desire to detract from the Canadians' victory.

They intend to get even "to-day if possible when they meet the Foothills and the Parkmen, Toronto Granite players in the afternoon, on the latter's ice. The fixtures for to-morrow include the competition for the Stewart Cup.
