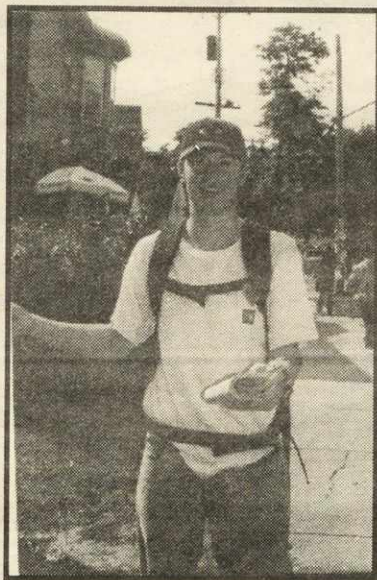

Question: Where do you think your University degree is going to get you in life?



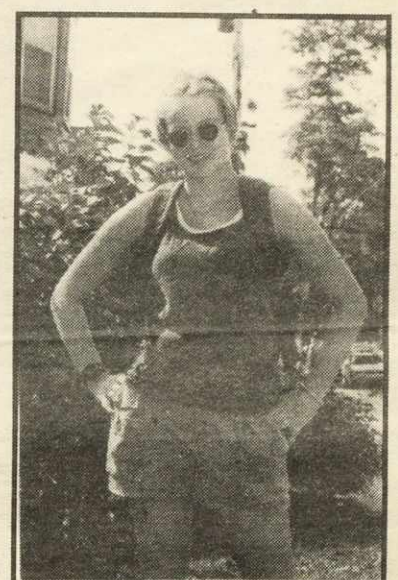
"Hopefully a job in Computing Science in either Ottawa or Halifax."

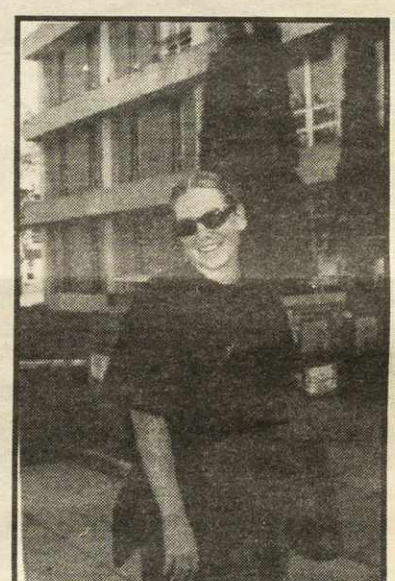

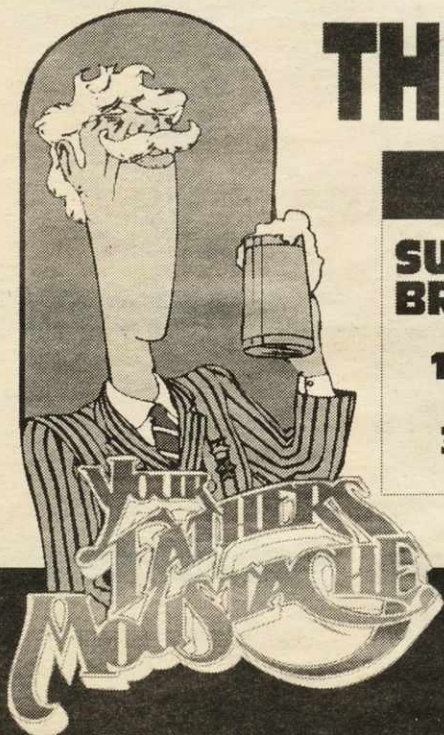
