Task force to study city's administrative setup

Mississauga is to establish a task force of five council members to study the city's administrative structure.

The idea was proposed this week by Ward 6 Councillor Fred Hooper and endorsed in

a 7-1 vote by general committee.

Hooper made the suggestion as councillors were considering what to do with a proposed chief administrative officer, bylaw, which would

set out the functions and duties of the city manager.

In view of the five new members of council and some apparent concern from staff about the administrative

structure, Hooper felt the task force was a good idea.

The rest of council agreed, but there was some discussion about whether the task force should include just five members or the entire 10-person council.

Councillor Hazel McCallion pledged her "utmost support" for the idea. She said some members of the previous council had tried to initiate such an overall study, but had been unsuccessful.

Interchange plans

The plans were on display at Clarkson Secondary School last week for viewing by area residents. Work is scheduled to begin on the interchange in 1978.

Meadowvale group backs plan

The Meadowvale West Homeowners Association has endorsed the concept plan presented to it by the planning department at a public meeting last September.

In a letter to council, homeowners' president Ken Dear said the plan, which reduces the density of the community to just over 30,000 people, had been endorsed by the homeowners.

The meeting was held as a result of concerns by residents that the variety of housing, and especially the apartment buildings envisioned in the original development plan, were not being provided.

In several instances, con-

dominium townhouses have been built where apartments were originally planned.

An application for condominium townhouses at the southwest corner of Montevideo and Derry Roads, originally proposed for apartments, sparked the residents' concerns.

The planning report presented to the public meeting recommends that every effort be made to provide a maximum variety of housing types. It also suggests that no further reduction in apartments or density be allowed.

Official Plan Amendment 218, passed in 1968, originally

called for a population of 35,700 in Meadowvale West. Under the newest concept plan, the eventual population will be 30,400.

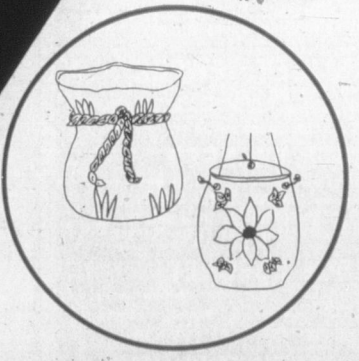
