In reply to letter No. 417657 dated Oct. 22nd. 1915 in reference to the purchasing of a portion of the Brocket Station Grounds from the Canadian Pacific Railway, I may say that I examined the land and think it worth \$30.00 per acre.

Although not knowing the price paid for the land when taken from the Indians, I would suggest that an offer of the original price with interest be made the company, provided it did not bring the price to more than \$30.00 per acre.
