SYNOPSIS OF REGULATIONS

Inmates may correspond with and receive letters from relatives, both being censored by the Governor, to be in the English language, not exceeding two letters per month, excluding all objectionable matter. Misconduct will cancel this privilege.

Inmates will not be allowed the use of the telephone, but matters of importance may be communicated to the Governor, charges prepaid.

Newspapers, tobacco, food, clothing and postage prohibited. Money remittances to inmates to be sent to the Governor in trust.

Visiting hours 2 to 4 P.M. on Wednesday only. Sunday visiting prohibited unless written permission given to out of city relatives. Consultation with legal and spiritual advisers allowed between the hours of 9 A.M. and 4 P.M. unless written consent of the Governor to the contrary is obtained.

Inmates waiting trial may have the privilege of purchasing food and clothing and writing two letters per week.
