I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your latter of the 3rd instant, in reference to the request of the Lillonet Indians to be supplied with a sill for grinding thext whether The Department has not definite information in regard to the cost of a grinder for grinding ducat late flows, fact well at Ottawa), which it is presumed is what shop refer to, but it is thought it would nost between \$1000,00 and \$2000,00, and the Department could not authorise so large at expanditure dusing the present fiscal year, as sooners must be practiced. The Pepartment desires, however, to be informed of the distance. the Indians have to draw their wheat to a grist mill. The Tesact grinder for grinding feed for stock wan be purchased in Ottawa for 836.90.
