Referring to your letter of the 13th instant, I re-enclose herewith the voucher amounting to \$42.00 which you submitted in favour of Jos. Greek for relief supplies furnished to members of the Batchewanna Band, and I beg to say that it will be necessary for the account attached to the said voucher to be amended, so as to show the quantity of each article supplied. As you should be aware all accounts should be rendered in detail before being presented to the Department. They cannot be properly audited unless the price per pound etc. is shown in every instance.

There are charges in the above account for sugar and syrup. You should warn the merchants against continuing to make issues of syrup. If such charges appear in accounts in future, they will be disallowed before payment of the account is made.
