Dear Sir:


Enclosed is a "World Citizens's International Identity Card". I feel that it symbolically represents the hopes of all men for the security and peace which the title "world citizen" implies.

We who would be real world citizens under the protection of a representative international authority look to you in the coming months for the leadership without which the world will sink back into the misery and chaos of another insane war. We look to you to utilize the brief moments ahead to initiate the processes which are available to you through Article 109 of the Charter which calls for a review conference and is not subject to veto, to open the way for the creation of this international authority. There is no longer any middle ground. Nothing less than a World government can save mankind.

I have asked the people whom you represent through your sovereign nation to ask you to sign these cards which will in effect be a declaration of world government by your nation. I have asked them to inform their own governmental representatives of their deep desire for peace through this only means by which peace is possible. No major issue in the world today is capable of solution until political unity is first established.

Our world is not-so-slowly coming apart. You have the means of welding it together. Will you through resolution declare yourself for this unity? We, the people, await your answer.
