In 1888 William Lyon Mac-
kenzie ran for parliament. In
his address to the electors he
said:

"I have no end in view but the
well-being of the people at large
—no ambition but that of con-
tributing to the happiness and
prosperity of our common coun-
try. The influence and author-
ity with which you may invest
me shall always be directed, ac-
cording to the best of my judg-
ment, for the general good; and
it will be my care to uphold your
rights to the utmost of my
power, with that firmness, mod-
eration and perseverance, which
become the representative of a
free people."
