I first served at Convalescent Depot in France awaiting re-allocation to a Regt. I was sent myself on 26 Sept 1944 at about 1400 hrs. On the 2nd Oct 44 I was arrested in Paris by the Can. Provost at about 13.00 hrs. I was kept in close arrest in Paris until 12 Oct 1944 when I was escorted to 2 C.B.R.C. Here I was sifted and despatched to my Regt passing through 46 Forward Rndr Coy. on the same day. I remained about 1st of Oct for 12 days under open arrest. On 9th 24 Oct 44 I was returned to 46 Forward Rndr Coy. under close arrest. I was never released from close arrest, as there were no charges or evidence. I was kept employed at 46 Fwd Coy until 7 Dec 44, when I was again returned to 2 C.B.R.C. 138th. Here I was again detained in the guard room until on or about the 15 Dec 44, when I again went absent. I was again arrested on 18 Dec 44 at about 1630 hrs. I have been under close arrest since that date. On 11 Dec 44 I received a letter from my mother informing
