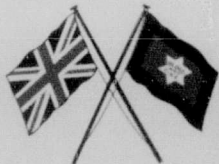

On 9 Feb 42 Sgt Rose 2 Prov Coy handed me pistol S & W 380 with a report on the revolver placed it in safe place - examined 23 Feb by Capt Allan McPherson CID - 25 Feb received it from him after examination - under lock & key since - Gun now produced in court as an exhibit and marked 1st exhibit.

Cross-examined by def. officer witness stated he had the only key to box where revolver was kept in the DAPM's office

2nd witness Capt McPherson, 4th Can Corp, on Mon 23 Feb 42, Capt Kizley brought pistol from which numbers & gov stamp filed off. Inside wooden cut was ^{stamped} A737518 - on the
