		Whereas the Commissioners do think absolutely necessary for the security of these Her Majestys Frontiers to send spies into the Heart of Canada to observe what the preparations of the French of Canada are making they have therefore agreed with Appom and Pamelos and three Three Indians to go from hence this day and are to return here <del>to day</del> in 30 days time and also to invite Katoialet one of the Indians who deserted from hence and doth daily great mischief to our Brethren of New England and is thought by his coming here to live in his native country to prevent the like for the future and also to Invite Mannumuk Onagosis and Schomondo to come here the two last being made children of this Government by the Commission and had promised to be here 30 days ago.	336
