

Caution:—

When a soldier is carrying a rifle never salute to the forehead.

C. When in Uniform:—

(1) Never salute when in the Ranks. If spoken to by an Officer come to Attention.

(2) All Officers of any unit when in uniform or when recognized must be given a salute.

(3) WHEN PASSING an officer salute properly and smartly with the hand further away and turn the head and eyes in his direction. Salute on the third pace before reaching him and lower the hand on the third pace after passing him. When carrying a cane or small parcel place it under the arm nearer the officer before saluting. If two or three men are passing an Officer the time is taken from the man nearest the officer.

(4) IF STANDING, when an officer passes, turn towards him, come to attention and salute with the right hand at three paces distance, if carrying a rifle stand at attention only; do not salute with the hand.

(5) When approaching to speak to an officer halt and salute at two paces distance. If at the slope remain so unless detained by the officer when arms
