

4th. The Company shall have authority to make a tunnel under the highway for the conveyance of the property of the Company, and the passage of their carriages and workmen between the quarries and shipping places, provided that the free use of such highway shall not be interrupted at any time, and that the highway shall be perfectly secured by arches or other substantial work to the satisfaction of the Sessions.

5th. No member of the corporation shall be liable in his person or separate estate for the debts of the Company for a greater amount, in the whole, than the amount of the stock held by him.

6th. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to interfere with, alter, or affect the right of Her Majesty or any body corporate, or private individuals.
