as own knowledge without previously vacating the chair and calling thereto some qualified member.

- 19 During an intermission, opening, initiation, and while a vote is being taken, the doors shall be closed and no one permitted to enter or retire from the Lodge room.
- 20. No member shall be required to serve on a committee if at the time of appointment he is a member of two other committees.
- 21. The member first named on a committive shall be the chairman thereof for the purpose of calling it together and until another has been elected by the committee.
- 22. When the previous question has been moved and seconded it shall be put in this form: "Shall the main question be now put?" And if decided in the affirmative, the vote shall be taken on all incidental questions in proper order until the whole subject haf been disposed of.
 - 23. No part of these Ryles of Order shall be repealed or amended unless a proposition in writing, stating the change, shall be made at one regular convention previous to the time of its being acted upon and adopted by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, but any one of them, or any part thereof, may be suspended for the time being by a vote of two-thirds of the members present.
