AN ACT for the better regulation of the Fisheries in the Inferior District of Gaspé, and in the Counties of Cornwallis and Northumberland.

[9th March, 1824.]

WHEREAS the Fisheries, in the Inferior District of Gaspé, and in the Counties of Cornwallis and Northumberland, are of great importance to the Trade of this Province: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
