The Legislative Council have passed the following Bills, with amendments, to which they desire the concurrence of this House:—

Bill, intituled, "An Act to amend chapter twenty-six of the Consolidated Statutes for "Lower Canada, in so far as it relates to certain Water-courses."

Bill, intituled, "An Act to confirm certain By-laws of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the County of *Oxford*, and to confirm sales of land for taxes imposed "under and by virtue of the said By-laws."

Bill, intituled, "An Act to confirm the settlement made by *Charlotte Henderson*, deceased, of an undivided moiety of lands in *Bytown*, otherwise *Ottawa City*, in the Province of *Upper Canada*, and to invest the entirety of the same lands in Trustees, with "powers of sale and management."
