Mr. Speaker, under the provisions of chapter four of the Consolidated Statutes of *Canada*, called upon Mr. *Morris*, Member for the South Riding of the County of *Lanark*, to take the Chair during his temporary absence.

Bill, intituled, "An Act to amend chapter twenty-six of the Consolidated Statutes for "Lower Canada, in so far as it relates to certain Water-courses."

Bill, intituled, "An Act to confirm certain By-laws of the Municipal Council of the . "Corporation of the County of *Oxford*, and to confirm sales of land for taxes imposed " under and by virtue of the said By-laws."
